3.	Publication of the list of duly Nominated Candidates	Wednesday, the 4 th September, 2019 till 6.00 p.m.
4.	Last date for withdrawal of Nominations	Thursday, the 5 th September, 2019 till 12.00 noon
5.	Publication of final list of Candidates	Thursday, the 5 th September, 2019 till 5.00 p.m.
6.	Date of Election	Thursday, the 12 th September, 2019
7.	Timings of Voting	8.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.
8.	Counting of Votes	To begin immediately after the elections are over
