

Behavioural Economics

The Department of Economics offers a Certificate Course in Behavioural Economics that involves about 36 hours of teaching, discussion and assessment spread over approximately 12 sessions. Classes are held in Hindu College or online on weekends/holidays/after college hours/based on availability of faculty. It is a Certificate Course, with the certificate to be issued by Hindu College, University of Delhi. 80% attendance in sessions is mandatory to be eligible for certification.

Course Objectives:

1. Familiarise the students with the promising field of Behavioural Economics.
2. To understand individual decision-making of economic actors beyond the lens of rationality.
3. To view the world of Finance from a behavioural perspective.
4. To integrate this understanding into a broader policy based analysis.
