			CO2	They will learn ancient scripts and use their knowledge in studying more inscriptions later.
			CO3	Students will be able to read, collate and interpret inscriptions to reconstruct history.
			CO4	Thus, it will be useful for students who are interested in pursuing advance study in archaeology.

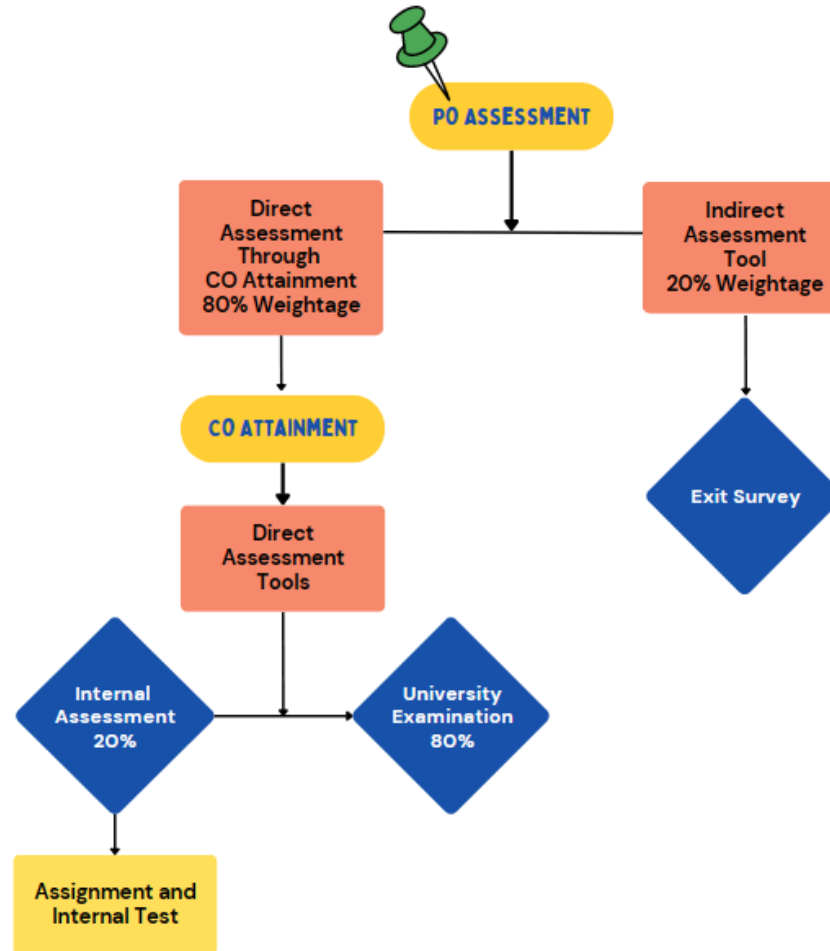

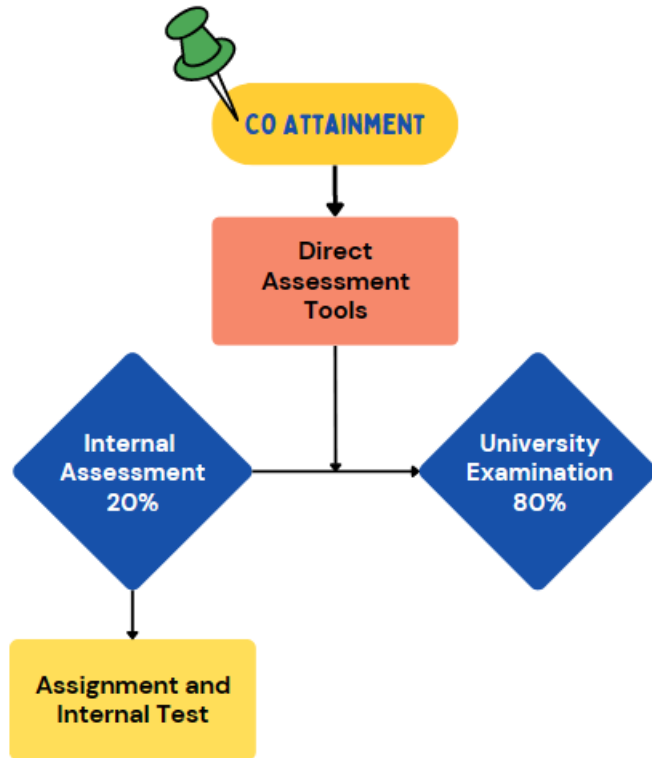

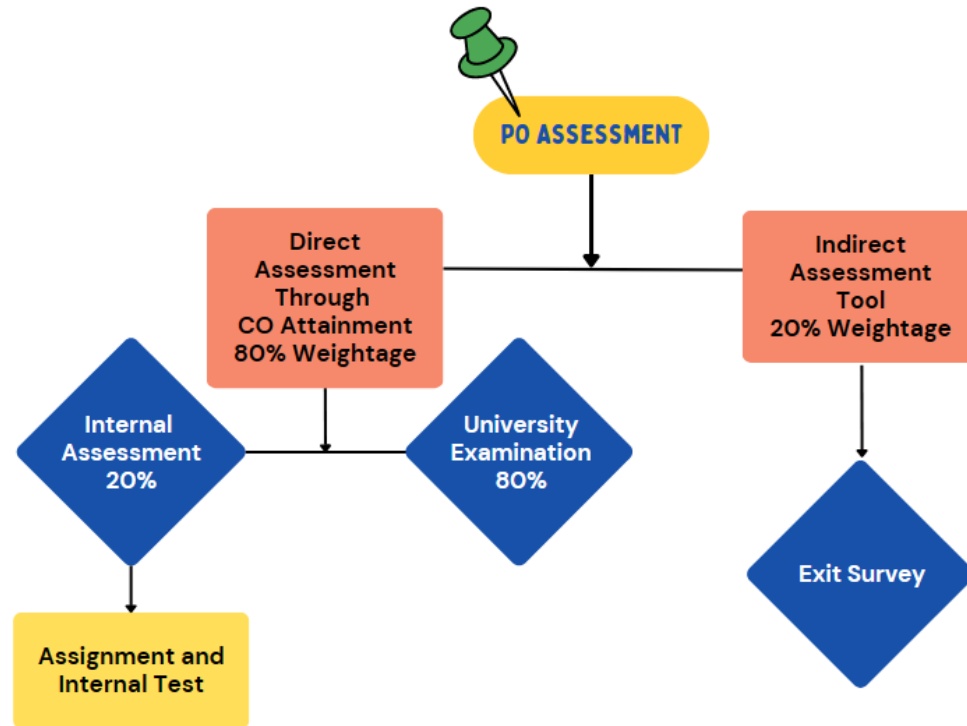
