Examination Results – 2021

Hindu College has always striven for excellence. As always, we had good examination results this year. At the Under-Graduate level, out of 1199 students who took the various final University Examinations, 1178 were successful, giving a pass percentage of 98.24. 1094 or 92.86% were placed in the First Division, 79 or 6.70% obtained Second Division and 5 or 0.42% got Third Division. At the Postgraduate level, out of 425 students who took various final University Examinations, 413 were successful, giving a pass percentage of 97.17. Out of these 386 or 93.462% were placed in first Division, 27 or 6.537 obtained second division and no third division.

Scholarships

The quality and caliber of our students is also reflected in the large number of scholarship holders in the college. In the year 2020-21, 552 Students applied for the Inspire Scholarship, 320 Students have applied for the National scholarship through NSP portal, 21 students of Jammu & Kashmir received scholarships through the Prime Minister Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS), 11 students received the ICCR scholarship, 5 students received the National Institute the Visually Handicapped Scholarship [NIVH], 14 students received Help the Blind Foundation Scholarship, 52 students received various college scholarships. In

addition, Financial Assistance was given to 115 students from the College Student Aid Fund and 157 students enjoyed Fee concession.

Inauguration of Auditorium and Amphitheatre

On October 8, 2021, the Science Block and the UTSAV Amphitheatre were inaugurated by Hindu College alumnus, the Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas, and the Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs, Shri Hardeep Singh Puri. The science block as well as the amphitheater are two architectural marvels that now grace the Hindu College campus. In addition to these two, the college auditorium, named Sanganeria Auditorium, also underwent a complete makeover in a span of just 14 months, and is now fully air-conditioned, with acoustic interiors, comfortable seating, excellent green rooms and a grand stage, comparable to any modern movie theater. Shri Sant Sanganeria Ji, Chairman and MD, Ultra International, generously supported the construction of the Science Block to promote the spirit of scientific education. UTSAV, the Amphitheatre, was constructed and developed in the fond memory of Professor Prem Chand, a former faculty member who was also the speaker of Hindu College Parliament for almost 40 years.

College Orientation Programme

Owing to the pandemic, the college admitted another batch of freshers to its community, entirely online. To welcome the Batch of 2024, Hindu College organized an online Orientation Programme on November 17, 2021. The programme was held via Zoom, and simultaneously broadcast live on Facebook and Youtube. It included cultural performances by Adhrita, the Classical Dance Society, and Alankaar, the Indian Music Society of Hindu College, and addresses by the Principal, Prof. Anju Srivastava, the Speaker of the College Parliament, Dr. Maneesha Pandey, Vice Principal Dr. Reena Jain, and Dr. Venika Krishna, College Counselor, among others. The programme also consisted of the screening of a short documentary on Hindu College's new facilities, called *Naye Pankh, Naye Udaan*. The Orientation was very well-attended and provided an excellent introduction of the college and its many aspects to the incoming batch. The College Orientation was followed by individual orientations by all departments for their respective students. On the following two days, November 18-19, 2021, the students of the new batch got to interact with various college societies.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES OF THE COLLEGE

National Youth Day (12 January 2021)

On the occasion of National Youth Day, an event "Plant a Tree With Us" was organized on January 12, 2021. To honor the birthday of Swami Vivekanand, an online meet was conducted wherein students took a pledge, indicative of their dedication to the unity, security and integrity of the nation.

Samvaad 2021 (6-7 March 2021)

This year, NSS HINDU's annual conclave "Samvaad" was a two- day event. On its first day (March 6, 2021), the conclave commenced with a musical performance by the music society of Hindu College 'Alankaar' after which the audience was addressed by our very own programme officer Mr. Vijay Garg. The speakers on the first day included Maj. Gen. PK Saighal, who spoke about his work in social service, Mr. Devir Singh Bhandari, who talked about filmmaking in India, Mr. Salil Acharaya, actor, RJ and anchor, the poet and author Lakshmi Shankar Bajpai, and Mr. Vikram Dogra. The speakers on the second day included Mr. Aman Dhatarwal, youtuber and motivational speaker, Mr. Kripa Shankar, the famous wrestling coach. The event ended with a session by Abhimanyu Singh Raghav.

Career Conference 2021 (9 April 2021)

NSS Hindu, with the Hindu College Counseling Centre organized a national conference on “Career & Well Being: Towards Healthy Career Choices' ' in collaboration with the Ministry of Education’s Manodarpan Initiative on 9 April, 2021. The talk aimed to enlighten students about optimal career choices. The session featured panelists from various spheres of the society.

Scribe

During the pandemic, the Scribe Wing of the NSS did not stop and was in regular and continuous contact with PwD students to provide them with every sort of help. The wing started the recording of various study materials and question papers for differently abled students, in which about 35 recordings of study material and few pdfs of question papers have been recorded. The wing has also volunteered in writing assignments for the completion of credits in which around 26 written assignments have been done till now in which both as simple paper and research files, project files are included. The wing also provided volunteers to PwD candidates for writing university exams and competitive exams.

Media

The paradigm shift towards the adoption of the digital mode during the pandemic boosted the working of the Media Wing of the NSS, whose responsibilities include designing posters, writing content, social media handles’ captions and reports after successful completion of events, important days, pledges, meetings, making and compiling videos. The Wing also worked in logo- making, template and certificate designing for Suruchi and Samvaad.

Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav

Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav is a series of events organized by the government of India spanning over 75 weeks to commemorate the 75th anniversary of Independence. It’s a part of our Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi’s vision of building a new Atma Nirbhar Bharat by the year 2022. Over the academic session, the college conducted many activities and events, as part of this series, as follows:

Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav -Webinar

As part of this series, the college organized an inaugural webinar on the topic “Gandhi: Independence and Beyond” on 16th July 2021. The webinar featured eminent speakers namely Professor Ramesh Chandra Bhardwaj, Head of the Department of Sanskrit, University of Delhi and the Director of the Gandhi Bhavan, University of Delhi, who spoke about the motivating factors behind the freedom movement, Dr. Chandrachur Singh, an Associate professor at the Department of Political Science, Hindu College, who spoke on “Future as Present- Why the Mahatma matters more than ever...”, and Dr Archana Verma, an Associate professor at the Department of History, Hindu College, who spoke on the topic “Gandhi's Vision for India- it matters”. Hindu College, with its glorious history, is proud of its own contribution to the nationalist movement. As the center for political debate and discourse during the freedom struggle, Hindu College has a longstanding and cherished linkage with the movement for independence. This webinar was an attempt towards interpreting and reliving the nationalistic values emanating from the life and teachings of the Mahatma. The event started off with a performance of the Gandhi Bhajan by students of Hindu College, which was followed by an address delivered by Dr. Maneesha Pandey, the speaker of the Hindu College Parliament. The session also featured cultural performances by members of Alankaar, The Indian Music Society of Hindu College. They performed Gandhi Bhajan, “Aabhar” a self-composed tribute to Gandhi, and “Dhyanor Bharot Pranor Bharot” a patriotic song from the North East. Professor Ramesh Chandra Bhardwaj, in his talk in Hindi on Swatantrata andolan ke prerak tatva (स्वतंत्रता आंदोलन के प्रेरक तत्व), wonderfully articulated the contributing factors in the freedom struggle along with comparing the past with the present. He elaborated on our abandonment of our indigenous learning systems to adopt western ones. He stated that we need to concentrate not just on building smart cities, but on villages too; true progress can only be made together. The need of the hour is to make an effort towards molding India to the visions that our freedom fighters had had.

Azadi: An Essay Writing Competition

NSS celebrated the birth anniversary of the great iron man of India, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel under the aegis of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' on the 30th and 31st of October 2021. The birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel is celebrated as National Unity Day or Rastriya Ekta Diwas every year. The celebration included a series of competitions and seminars ranging from Panel Discussions to Poster making Competition, and a webinar on the legacy of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, which was graced by the auspicious presence of Professor Kapil Kumar, Director, School of Tourism, Hospitality Service management Indira Gandhi National Open University and Professor Yuthika Mishra, Associate Professor, Department of History, Vivekananda College, University of Delhi and Professor Anju Srivastava, Principal Hindu college.

Hindu Consulting Group

Hindu Consulting Group (HCG) is a pro bono consulting society of Hindu college which has been operational since 2019, assisting innovative startups and NGOs with their problems. HCG successfully completed 10 projects in 2021-22. It set up the Research and Analytics vertical in 2021, promoting the culture of research in the society. The members work on Research papers, of which one has been published at the conference of SDMIMD. HCG hosted 9 knowledge sessions, one 3-day workshop and 7 case and guesstimate solving sessions. Collaborating with Grad Partners, it created the first series of the Case Book, which has been accessed by more than 1250 people.

Hindu College Innovation and Startup Cell

On the mandate of Ministry of Human Resource released a National Innovation and Startup Policy 2019 document (NISP), Hindu College has established Hindu College Innovation and Startup Cell (HCISC). HCISC has outlined the policy for students and faculty members of Hindu College to actively engage in innovation

This policy document will also evolve with time and adopt best practices to facilitate innovation and entrepreneurship in the Hindu College community. Our startup "Ionuva Innovations" at Hindu College is an ensemble of creative minds who have passion to contribute to the society through innovative research. The pandemic outbreak of COVID-19 caused by the novel coronavirus SARS-CoV-2, has disrupted all walks of life. All across the globe, efforts are being made by the scientific community to address this challenge towards mankind. Driven by the zeal to contribute to the fight against the pandemic and motivated by the Atma Nirbhar Bharat initiative of the Government of India, the research enthusiastic faculty and students of the Hindu College have developed a compact, cost-effective and efficient indigenous UV-C disinfection machine. The indigenous machine was launched on 8 October 2021 in the presence of many dignitaries.

के साथ वार्षिक साहित्यिक आयोजन 'अभिधा' का शुभारंभ हुआ। 23 अप्रैल 2021 को 'अभिधा' के दूसरे दिन 'भक्तिकाल की पुनर्व्याख्या की जरूरत' विषय पर भक्तिकाल के चर्चित अध्येता प्रो. माधव हाड़ा ने बताया कि भक्ति आंदोलन की पुनर्व्याख्या जरूर होनी चाहिए। 24 अप्रैल 2021 को 'अभिधा' के तीसरे और अंतिम दिन 'समकालीन हिंदी नाटक' विषय पर प्रो. आशीष त्रिपाठी ने समकालीन नाटक और रंगमंच की विशेषताओं का जिक्र करते हुए बताया कि भारतीयता की खोज समकालीन नाटक की सबसे अद्भुत विशेषताओं में से एक है जो अक्सर इस दौर के नाटकों में प्रदर्शित होती है। 31 जुलाई 2021 को महान कथाकार प्रेमचंद की 141वीं जयंती के अवसर पर 'प्रेमचंद को क्यों पढ़ें' विषय पर प्रो. अपूर्वानंद ने कहा कि प्रेमचंद पर बात करते हुए कुछ भी नया नहीं कहा जा सकता बल्कि सब दोहराया ही जाता है और दोहराने का शिक्षा और साहित्य दोनों में ही बहुत महत्व है। 14 सितंबर 2021 को 'हिंदी दिवस' के अवसर पर 'भारतीय साहित्य की अवधारणा' विषय पर 'डॉ. दीपक सिन्हा स्मृति व्याख्यान' का आयोजन किया गया जिसमें प्रो. अवधेश प्रधान ने भारतीय साहित्य जैसे बहुआयामी विषय के अनेक नए एवं सूक्ष्म आयामों से परिचय कराया। 9 अक्टूबर 2021 को 'गांधी : एक असंभव संभावना' विषय पर श्री तुषार गांधी ने गांधी को संभव बताते हुए कहा कि समाज में जो समस्याएं आती रही हैं, उनका निराकरण करने के लिए गांधी के जीवन से समाधान मिलते रहें हैं। 10 मार्च 2021 को हस्तलिखित पत्रिका 'हस्ताक्षर' और भित्ति-पत्रिका 'लहर' एवं 'अभिव्यक्ति' के नए अंकों का लोकार्पण कार्यक्रम हुआ। अभिधा के अंतर्गत 22 एवं 23 अप्रैल 2021 को 'अंतर्महाविद्यालयी साहित्यिक प्रश्नोत्तरी' एवं 24 अप्रैल 2021 को 'अंतर्महाविद्यालयी लोकगीत गायन' प्रतियोगिता का आयोजन किया गया।

Economics

The session started on a bittersweet note with the juniors bidding goodbye to their seniors in a first ever online farewell. The department organized lectures by eminent personalities like Dr. Arun Kumar and Professor Ram Singh who shared their intellectual insights with the students. Moreover, the department placed a special emphasis on the after-graduation opportunities for the students by organizing Pre-Placement Talks and Mentorship Sessions on topics like MBA, post-graduation studies, internships etc., in which experienced seniors provided much-needed guidance to the juniors. The Debating Society conducted a plethora of activities, including mocks, knowledge sessions, and workshops. The society hosted its flagship event, Annual Premchand Memorial Parliamentary Debate, from 2nd to 4th April and 12th to 14th November, 2021. The other prominent event hosted by the society was the Shri Sanjay Shrivastava Memorial Conventional Debate, which was held on 16th April, 2021. The society held a series of workshops, preceding the 19th Annual Premchand Memorial Debate, which was open to university students across the country, and saw great participation. The society members participated in various national and inter-collegiate debate tournaments, and achieved accolades at some of the most prestigious institutions in India, including NLS Bangalore, IIT Delhi, Christ University, St. Stephens’ College, CNLU, NLUJ amongst others.

IBTIDA – The Dramatics Society

The society conducted a workshop on screenplay for its members, with Hriday Rao Chauhan as a resource person, which included topics like scripting, camera handling, camera settings, editing among others. Another workshop conducted was about the basics of playing percussion instruments, with Satyamitran Guruhari as the resource person. A workshop was also conducted on improvisational theatre. In November 2021, Ibtida participated in the elimination round of IIT Mumbai's annual fest, Mood Indigo, which is Asia's Biggest Cultural Festival. Earthlings – The Wildlife Society

The year began with Earthlings hosting its 4th session of Annual Campus Bird Count on 22nd February, 2021, in association with NINOX - Owl About Nature and E-Bird India. The annual festival of the society, GAIA was held from 2-5 March, 2021, under which there were three fundraiser workshops held on the 2nd and 4th of March – first on wildlife photography, by Vinod Bartakke, a wildlife photographer and an independent filmmaker; second on animal laws, vaccination, adoption and first -aid with Anushca Bindra, founding member of MowgliAid; third on Origami with Himanshu Agrawal, an Origami practitioner since 1989. The festival also hosted a few interactive sessions – on 3 March, 2021 on “Balcony Birding” with Neha Sinha, a renowned Conservation Biologist; on 4 March, 2021 with Rizwan Mithawala, Conservation Writer, and Former environment journalist, The Times of India. A festival was concluded with a panel discussion on the “Influence of Eco-activism and Politics on Conservation”, and “Evolution of Conservation” with Dr. Sachin Anil Punekar, Mr. Arun Krishnamurthy, Mr. Soumyadeep Datta, and Ms. Puja R. Bhale on 5 March, 2021. This year the society inaugurated JATAYU- the animal care wing of Earthlings, with People for Animals (PFA) Campus on March 27, 2021. In collaboration with e-Junki, a sustainable E-waste Management company based out of New Delhi, an E-waste Management Awareness Session was organized on 16 July, 2021. The society hosted two webinars on “Saving Lives over Phones: Mobile Technology and Community Participation to Promote Human Elephant Coexistence in Contested Landscapes of South India” by M. Ananda Kumar, senior scientist, Nature Conservation Foundation, Mysore, on 12 August, 2021; and "Shark Tourism in Today's Time- Pros and Cons" by Ms.Vydehi Kadur, creative head and production manager at Felis Creations, followed by a discussion on ‘How to be a Conscious Traveler when you Visit Shark Habitats?’ on 30 August, 2021. The

society organized an Inter-college Creative Art Competition, on the occasion of World Cassowary Day, on 26 August, 2021, and an Inter-college Makeup and Styling contest on the occasion of Big Butterfly month in September. There was also an intra-society discussion session organized on the topic “Advancement in Technology- a Boon or Curse for Wildlife?” on 23 November, 2021. Earthlings also maintained an active social media presence with several awareness campaigns on issues such as World Environment Day, World Population Day, World Lion Day, World Cleanup Day, Zero Emission Day, Human wildlife Conflict, Wildlife Tourism, etcetera.

Science Forum

The society’s annual festival Scientia’21 began on February 25, 2021, with an online live extempore competition, The Stage Awaits You! Later that day, a webinar on ‘Intersection of Protein Biophysics and Synthetic Biology’ by Dr. Stephen Fried, Assistant Professor, Department of Biology, Johns Hopkins University in Baltimore, US was organized. On February 25, 2021, a General Science Quiz Competition, Quizzaria was held. On February 27, 2021, another interactive Webinar on ‘Lichen Biotechnology’ by Dr. Eugênia C. Pereira was organized. She is a Professor of Geography and Plant Biology at Universidade Federal de Pernambuco, Brazil. The festival also included poster making, essay writing, and photography competitions. Over the course of the academic session, the society also organized presentations and discussions on various topics including ‘plastic pollution’, ‘melting ice caps’, ‘carbon footprint’ etc. On July 1, 2021, a webinar on Data Science by Mr. Suraaj Hasija, Senior Data Scientist at Master Card with expertise in the fields of analytics and finance was organized. Over the course of the academic session, the society actively posted articles on its website, on significant issues like Nuclear Energy, Impact of rising sea temperature on marine life, Causes of cancer in Human beings, Acute Encephalitis Syndrome, Implementation of nanotechnology, Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy: A Prone Disease etc. On August 31, 2021, the first debate session was held on the topic ‘Is technology helping people become smarter or is it making them dumber?’.
