






SAMPLE PROOF

ENTHAPLY OF NEUTRALIZATION

Aim: To determine the enthalpy of neutralization of ethanoic acid with ammonium hydroxide using Hess' Law.

Introduction:

Heat involved during neutralization of an acid with alkali. The neuralization reaction of strong acid with strong base is essentially the combination of one equivalent of $H^{\scriptscriptstyle +}$ ion with one equivalent $OH^{\scriptscriptstyle -}$.

Enthalpy of neutralization is heat evolved when one gram equivalent of acid is completely neutralized by a base in dilute solution.

The chemical reaction is given below:

$$H^{+}_{(aq)} + OH^{-}_{(aq)}$$
 $\longrightarrow H_{2}O$ -13.76 kcal $H^{+}_{(aq)} + CI^{-}_{(aq)} + Na^{+}_{(aq)} + OH^{-}_{(aq)}$ $\longrightarrow Na^{+}_{(aq)} + CI^{-}_{(aq)} + H_{2}O$ -13.67 kcal

Where,13.67 kcal released is the heat of neutralization for all strong acid and strong base.

Enthalpy of neutralization: When aqueous solution of acids and bases react, heat is evolved. This heat change accompanying a neutralization is termed as the heat of neutralization and is defined as the amount of het evolved when one gram equivalent of an acid is neutralized by one gram-equivalent of a strong base, both being taken as dilute aqueous solutions.

<u>Hess' law</u>: According to this law, "The heat absorbed or released in a given chemical equation is the same whether the process occur in one step or a several steps.
