Code of Ethics

Preamble

Hindu College is committed to deliver quality education by following the highest academic standards (HAS) in line with the norms of Higher Education (HE) in India. The Code of Ethics (COE) aims at serving a guideline for upholding ethical principles in the organization.

Scope

The institution has a prescribed code for the authorities, faculty, support staff and students who need to comply with the code of ethics and adhere to the principles of behavior stated herein.

Principles of Ethical Behaviour

As per the code, key principles and behavior revolving around some of the integral themes such as personal integrity, Ethics in research, Professional

Ethics at Workplace, professional ethics in third party interactions, college expects of its members have been outlined:-

1. Personal Integrity:

The guiding principles of personal integrity include:-

- (i) Honesty
- (ii) Accountability
- (iii) Responsibility
- (iv) Transparency
- (v) Respect

Every individual associated with the college in some or the other position must maintain honesty and truthfulness in their behavior in all the interpersonal dealings, treat everyone with respect, manage interpersonal conflicts with justice, display inclusiveness, appreciate diversity and abide by all the norms and guidelines of the institute.
