Mode of Public participation:

Various statutory bodies of the University, namely the University Court, EC and AC comprises of eminent people from society and representatives of public who directly participate in the affair of the University.

- (a) The University Court has the following representation from the public:
- ten persons representing certain professions and industry and commerce
 - three Members of Parliament (two from Lok Sabha and one from Rajha Sabha)
 - two persons of the Delhi Legislative Assembly
 - Chairman, CBSE
 - five persons nominated by the Visitor (President of India)
 - one person nominated by the Chief Rector
 - two persons nominated by the Chancellor (Vice-President of India)
- (b) The Executive Council has the following representations form the public:
- four per representing certain professions, industry and commerce
 - two persons nominated by the Visitor (President of India)
 - one person nominated by the Chancellor (Vice President of India)
- (c) The Academic council co-opts two persons from the public for their special knowledge.
